

## Exhibition Room<sup>®</sup> "BATH ROOM"

The bath room assumed various functions and meanings in the past so that it would make a real historical reconstruction difficult. Bath room in the palace appered in early 1900s. In this room bathtub made of Carrara marble, toilet in 1700s style and vanity all together.

When first bathroom made, it was used to demonstrate the Lord's social distinction over the public as a room still considered superfluous for them. The primary importance was certainly not related to the cure their personal hygiene but was more important to show their elite state.

## Exhibition Room (10) "BEDROOM"

In old times the bedroom was not only for sleeping but also for enjoying talk or music with friends. This luxurious bed and cabinet are in Baroque style. The chandelier is called "Rezzonico", name of the palace in Venice, which is most popular design in 18th century.

Venetian aristocrats used to drink chocolate when waking up or before sleeping. Chocolate set made of beautiful Venetian glass showing its style.
